



OPEN WATER PART I

The Open Water course is divided into two parts. PART I involves series of classroom and pool training sessions. PART II is the application of learned skills during four open water certification dives commonly performed over one weekend. You also have the opportunity to complete your dives on one of our guided dive trips to the Caribbean or during your own vacation.

An Orientation will need to be scheduled prior to the start of the course to complete paperwork and review class requirements.

EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS:

Students need to provide their own **mask, snorkel, boots and fins**-students will receive a discount if purchased at THE DIVE SHOP. Scuba gear provided for class: tank, regulator with alternate air source, buoyancy compensator device (BCD), pressure and depth gauge, weight belt, weights, wetsuit and full support staff. Each student will receive a 15% discount when purchasing their BCD, regulator and dive computer package.

INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIAL INCLUDED IN CLASS FEE:

PADI instructional material: student folder, text book, log book, dive table and DVD.
We NEVER charge a fee for your referral form.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The minimum age to begin SCUBA diving is 10 with no age limit. You must be in reasonable health and be comfortable in the water. The course is taught in a friendly, relaxed atmosphere to enhance learning.
