



OPEN WATER PART II

The Open Water course is divided into two parts. PART I involves series of classroom and pool training sessions. PART II is the application of learned skills during four open water certification dives commonly performed over one weekend. You also have the opportunity to complete your dives on one of our guided dive trips to the Caribbean or during your own vacation.

EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS:

Students need to provide their own **mask, snorkel, boots and fins**. Students are responsible for lodging, meals, transportation and entrance fees if applicable. THE DIVE SHOP will provide all SCUBA gear to include 2 tanks, regulator with alternate air source, buoyancy compensator device (BCD), pressure and depth gauge, weight belt, weights, 7 ml wetsuit, hoods, gloves and certification card and full support staff. Each student will receive a 15% discount when purchasing their BCD, regulator and dive computer package.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

THE DIVE SHOP performs certification dives at Dutch Springs (www.dutchsprings.com) in Bethlehem, PA. The four open water dives required for certification are scheduled between May and October of each year. THE DIVE SHOP offers warm water travel destinations to achieve your certification and or to expand your diving knowledge and career.
